If your facility receives medications in blister cards, do you currently receive your patient-specific blister cards with each individual bubble of the blister card labeled with the medication's name and strength, lot number, expiration date, and manufacturer's name to allow those medications to be safely, and in many states legally, returned for credit?

A) Patient specific cards but not on each blister, not required.

Does your facility have:

- A state pharmacy license?
- Any type of State Board of Pharmacy-issued clinic license?
- A controlled substance registration to allow for prescription stock medications?

A) Our agency complies with all Federal and State Regulations.

Does your facility have a U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) registration, which is required to receive stock controlled substances (i.e., Schedule II-IV medications)?

A) Our agency complies with all Federal and State Regulations.

If not, is your facility's physical address listed as the business address on the DEA license of at least one of your facility's providers?

A) Our agency complies with all Federal and State Regulations.

Do you receive prescription stock in 30-count blister cards or in original manufacturers' bulk bottles?

A) We only stock OTC medications and stat boxes per Virginia Regulation.

If not, how is your current vendor providing your facilities with stock medications in accordance with the Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA) of 2013?

Item 5.d on page 8 of the RFP / Item 5.h on page 9 of the RFP / Item 8 on page 12 of the RFP

These items indicate that stock shall be provided in stock cards. A pharmacy or a wholesaler cannot simply put those medications in a card and label them as stock and still be in full regulatory compliance. (This also is required under item 8 on page 12 of the RFP.) A company must be an FDA-registered repackager or use the services of an FDA-registered repackager to legally repackage stock medications into blister cards or any other packaging that results in a change to the original manufacturer's packaging.

- Will you mandate that the pharmacy vendor comply with the regulations and use an FDA-registered repackager if stock is provided in packaging other than the original manufacturer's packaging?
- Will you require bidders to provide evidence (such as the repackager's license and labeler code) that they use an FDA-registered repackager?
- Will failure of a pharmacy bidder to comply with FDA repackaging regulations regarding the provision of stock deem that bidder non-compliant and therefore ineligible to receive an award?
A) Virginia does not allow stock blister packs. Vendor shall comply with all Federal and State Regulations.
